Terms of Entry:

- 1. The Bruce Challenge is a farmers walk where competitors will pick up an Olympic bar housing 2 Scottish boulders and then walk as far as they can with the furthest distance taking 1st place
- 2. The total weight of the Bruce Challenge bar and Scottish boulders is 164.5kg
- 3. Athletes must wear appropriate highland games attire when competing
- 4. Running order will be drawn from a hat on the day
- 5. When not competing and in the interests of health and safety all competitors must remove themselves from the field
- 6. Events will be held on a grass highland games field
- 7. Entry fee to this open event is £6 payable by BACS but if numbers permit, can be entered on the day.
- 8. Entries on the day will be at Judges' discretion and only if the limit of 8 competitors has not been exceeded.
- 9. The Judges' decision shall be final
 - a. Competitors have 1 attempt only
 - b. There will be no test lifts permitted beforehand
 - c. The Challenge starts once the competitor picks up the bar and the boulders are clear of the ground
 - d. There is no time limit, but The Challenge stops when any part of either boulder touches the ground
 - e. There will be no helping aids permitted (chalk only)
 - f. Competitors will walk the 20-metre circuit laid out by walking the distance, then round the pole and walk back and so on until rule 'd'
 - g. All final measurements will be taken up to the furthest back point of either boulder
 - h. If there is a tie, then competitors will start The Challenge again after drawing straws to see who goes first

IMPORTANT: Entry form must be signed and dated by entrants.

I hereby declare that I am medically fit to compete and that I will not hold the organisers or committee responsible for any injury, illness or loss to my person or property caused.

I agree to submit to the jurisdiction of the rulings and Judges decision and to all matters relative to the spirit of sportsmanship and anti-doping policy for this competition and I know of no reason why I should not be allowed to compete.
